The AUSA “Spirit” Grant is rewarded to competitive student organization recipients that propose a viable project that enhances the Andrews University community by honoring at least three of the following five themes: spirituality, unity and diversity, service, justice, innovation.

GUIDELINES:

1. Requests are only for the current year of programming and are not made to cover deficits from past years not to provide for accumulating an operating reserve.
2. Money must be deposited in and spent from an Andrews University Account and is not to be transferred to an off-campus account.
3. Grant requests are **up to \$1500** (maximum).

Please attach a proposal (not to exceed 4 pages) to this cover sheet that includes your responses to each of the items below in an organized typewritten paragraph form. Each page must be numbered with a header that includes the Proposal Title and Club/Organization name.

- Briefly describe the program/project for which you are seeking AUSA grant sponsorship.
- Please indicate how your project addresses or enhances at least one of the following five

themes:

- Spirituality
 - Unity and Diversity
 - Service
 - Justice
 - a Innovation
- Provide a timeline for the implementation of your program/project.
 - Please include a detailed budget that accounts for your requested grant amount.
